### Bib Pickup, Feb. 23-25

The 7th Annual CenturyTel Junior Birkie will be held on Friday, February 24th, at 9 a.m. until 1 p.m. at Telemark Resort in Cable. Youth skiers ages 10-12 and 13-15 can participate in the **3.5 kilometer Free Technique (skate or stride) Individual Race**. Each participant receives a medal and age class prizes will be awarded. The **Third Annual 3 by 3km High School Mass Start Relay** follows the conclusion of the 10-15 year old interval race. Team members must ski on the same High School team and be in grades 9-12. The event is limited to 75 teams. Team members should send in 3 applications in one envelope or register together on race morning. Registration is \$5 per skier and can be made by filling out the form located in the Pre-Race Issue of the Birch Scroll or by downloading the registration form under Junior Birkie in the Registration section of this web site.

New for this season is the **CXC Central High School Championships**. The top athletes



in their respective State Championships from Minnesota, Wisconsin, Michigan, Illinois and Ohio will be invited to race head to head. The Pursuit event will begin with a 3 km mass start free technique race, change to classic skis and poles in the stadium transition area and finish with a 3 km classic race. First across the line claims the title of CXC Central High School Champion!
