If you will recall, this issue started after a Round Lake resident sued the county over lake levels. The county then paid him I believe about \$500,000 and he sold his property and left the area.

If you recall, I stated at the first meeting, "today you

are complaining that the lake is too high and a year from now we could have a drought." Here we are a year and a-half later and we are in a drought. Now the county has spent \$100,000 more of taxpayer dollars to study what the Tribe has been saying all along — you can't control Mother Nature!

It is insulting to us (the Tribe) that county board supervisor Riedman is giving us a deadline of May 17 to perform a duty. She is not our boss! We will take our time with this issue! The engineering study that the county paid for only addressed impacts relative to Round Lake and did not address issues/ impacts that are relative to downstream Osprey Lake, Osprey Creek — on
