WEB EXCLUSIVE: Round Lake-Little Round dredging gets preliminary OK

At their June 10 meeting, the Sawyer County Highway Committee approved a request from some Round Lake property owners to hand-dredge the channel beneath the Highway B bridge at the Round Lake Narrows to improve boat navigation between Big and Little Round Lakes.

The committee's approval is the first of several procedural steps the project must take before work can start. Other steps include scheduling a DNR comment period and obtaining input from the LCO Tribe.

Jim Miller Excavating is spearheading the project, which will involve volunteers using shovels and buckets to dig a channel one foot deep and 20 feet wide. The material taken out would be transported to a sand pit on Highway B east of Famous Dave's. Highway Commissioner Gary Gedart said

the project has the support of the Round Lake Property Owners Association (RLPOA). There will be no cost to the county.

On another matter, the committee approved, on a one-year trial basis, a request from the Town of Sand Lake to designate one mile of Highway BB south of Stone Lake for a snowmobile and ATV corridor. It will connect Sissabagama Road with

Trail 31, running along Sloan Street and Stone Lake Road.

On another matter, Sawyer County 4-H Horse Project members Lauren and Angela Stutelberg, Katelyn LeBlanc and Ella Scherer presented a request to the committee from the fair board to truck soil for resurfacing the horse arena at the fairgrounds, to make it safer for riding and showing horses.

They asked the highway department to truck approximately 30 loads of dirt from John Williams' gravel pit to Dale Mrotek and from there to the fairgrounds. Mrotek is donating the screening of the sand/clay and the Town of Bass Lake is donating the loader. Jeremy Murdock is donating the final grading of the arena.

Sawyer County UW-Extension 4H Youth Agent Lori Laberee said placing the clay/sand mixture will keep rocks from surfacing. The kids will still have to pick rocks out every year.

The Sawyer County Fair Board has approved the project and the 4-Hers have raised some funds themselves.

The committee approved the request at an approximate cost of \$4,700 for labor and trucking.

"The nice thing is, it can be done at our leisure," Gedart said.

The committee authorized the highway department to mow the fairgrounds prior to the June 26 Sawyer County Dairy Breakfast and prior to the Aug. 19-22 Sawyer County Fair.
